ABOUT NORTHERN IRELAND



Your efforts in Northern Ireland will focus on sharing the Gospel and improving relations between Protestant and Catholics in Northern Ireland. The staff at the Murlough House hope to break the cycle of mistrust and animosity that has divided Northern Ireland for over 60 years. They want to be part of a new narrative where the Irish people are united by the love of Christ. At the start of your trip, you will be paired with a specific church in the area. Together with members of the local church congregation, you will go out into the community. Your primary mission will be to engage with people through after school visits, park ministry, and one on one connections.

📁 REQUIREMENTS

- ✓ All participants should have received a tetanus shot within the last 10 years.
- ✓ A doctor's signature is required on the medical form for participants under the age of 18. (A school physical less than one year old may work in place of the doctor's signature.)
- ✓ All participants 18 and older must complete a background check. Mission Discovery will provide the appropriate web address.
- ✓ Participants must have a passport that is valid at least 90 days after departure date.

📅 SCHEDULE

- * This is an example of how the week may run, however, flexibility will be the key word of the week.
- ✓ You will arrive on a Friday. Once all team members have arrived we will head to the Murlough House.
- ✓ Saturday will be a day of orientation and getting to know the area. If there is enough time you will visit one of the many local tourist attractions. Sunday morning will start by attending a church service with the congregation you will be working alongside during the week.
- ✓ On Monday, you will be out in the community engaging in a variety of social activities. Based on what your church partners have arranged, you could be visiting local schools, attending religious classes, or participating in park ministry or a kids club. You will receive a detailed schedule once you arrive. Your week will wrap up on Friday as you visit local sights and explore the city of Belfast. On Saturday, you will head back to the airport in time to return.
