Many Haitians dwell in desperation where physical, emotional and spiritual conditions are very difficult. Combining efforts with native partners, Mission Discovery teams are needed to address some of their basic needs such as food, clothing, housing, education, and, of ultimate importance, an opportunity to hear and understand the Gospel. Mission Discovery is collaborating with national and international ministries in an effort to redevelop communities, furthering them to be safe and thriving areas. The end goal is to produce sustainability for the people of Haiti as they move away from the spiritual and physical void that has been present for generations.

📁 REQUIREMENTS

- ✓ All participants should have received a tetanus shot within the last 10 years.
- ✓ A doctor's signature is required on the medical form for participants under the age of 18. (A school physical less than one year old may work in place of the doctor's signature.)
- ✓ All participants 18 and older must complete a background check. Mission Discovery will provide the appropriate web address.
- ✓ Participants must have a passport that is valid at least 6 months after departure date.
